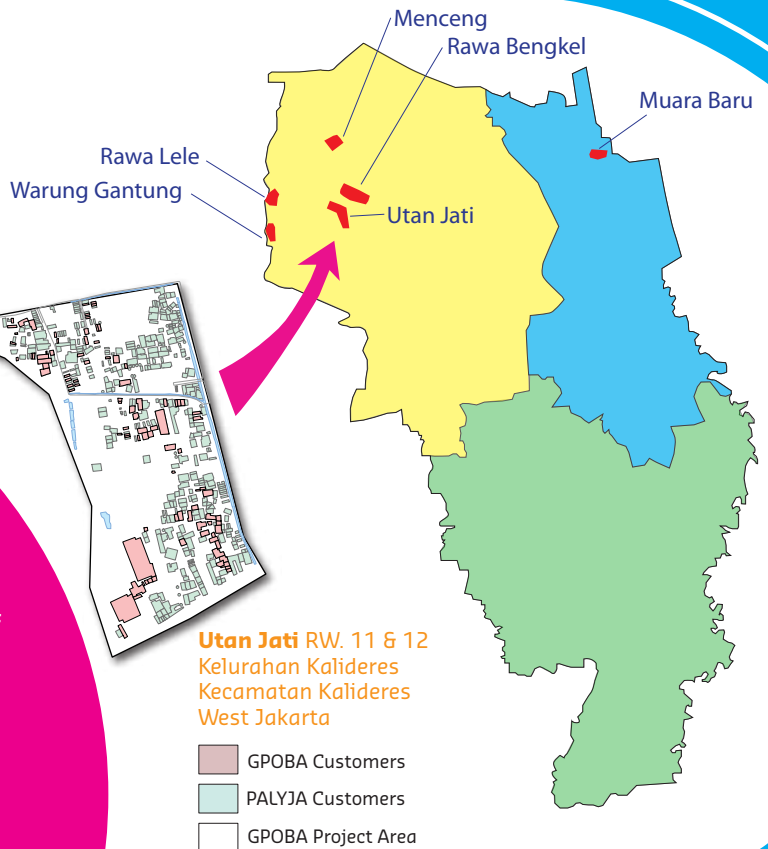
### GLOBAL PARTNERSHIP ON OUTPUT-BASED AID (GPOBA)

is a program to increase access to clean water for low-income communities, in underprivileged areas of Western Jakarta through clean water pipe connections, with the support from the World Bank. The GPOBA project started in April 2008.

### TOTAL NEW CONNECTIONS TARGET OF GPOBA PHASE 1 : 4,770 CONNECTIONS

Parties involved in GPOBA project : Pemda DKI Jakarta, PAM Jaya, World Bank, Jakarta Water Regulatory Body, KPAM Independent Auditor, Mercy Corps and PALYJA.

GPOBA projects are carried out in : Rawa Bengkel, Menceng, Muara Baru, Warung Gantung, Rawa Lele and Utan Jati.



### PALYJA GPOBA PROJECT UTAN JATI

The project in this area started since February 2009. Estimated population in this area is 2,271 households with a total of 804 GPOBA customers 1,133 PALYJA's standard customers and 334 households not yet connected.

With the GPOBA project, health indicators show that diarrhea diseases decreased by 16% and skin related diseases decreased by **24%**.
